- improve teaching staff capability through focused coaching and professional development.

Our initiatives include:

- continued development and implementation of a Daily Rapid Reading program
- extra teacher aide support in the Early Years classroom
- professional development for teaching staff to unpack the Australian Curriculum with a focus on North Coast Region and Cluster numeracy and literacy programs
- planning, moderation and coaching opportunities for classroom teachers to increase teacher capacity.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Action	Cost
Support the employment of a teacher aide to support literacy and numeracy teaching in Early Years classroom.	\$20 000
Update resources for Daily Rapid Reader program as required.	\$ 1 313
Release classroom teachers to attend professional development to unpack the Australian Curriculum (English and Mathematics).	\$ 8 000
Teacher release time to plan English and Mathematics units collaboratively, attend moderation sessions and participate in coaching sessions.	\$ 5 000
