
School review conducted 1 to 3 March 2023

Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Implement a review of the school's Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Plan to ensure that it is up-to-date, aligned, centrally accessible, and supports systematic curriculum delivery to all students.
- Collaboratively examine current and preferred practice informed by evidence-based research to develop a formalised and agreed whole-school approach to pedagogy.
- Collaboratively develop coaching opportunities for the principal and teachers to work together to implement the new collegial engagement framework.
- Further develop the capability and autonomy of teachers to take lead roles in guiding aspects of the school improvement agenda.
- Build the capability of teachers to consistently implement differentiated, focused and intensive teachers responsive to student needs to support all students to access, participate and progress through the curriculum.
